PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Happy Spring GGG,

As we all have noticed, our weather since the first day of Spring has been anything but Spring like! Really glad our meeting day dawned sunny and clear. Had we had the previous days weather with the hailstorms and traffic mess would have erred on the safe side and rescheduled the meeting. The noontime hailstorm that rolled through caught Marsha and I out shopping. We were driving in town so way less of an issue than being on a bridge or the freeway. Upon arriving at our next stop we sat in the truck for about 15 minutes as the rain just dumped. I saw later in the day on the

National Weather Service website we received .44 inches in about 75 minutes, torrential by Bay Area standards. Members came yesterday from 5 counties making for many miles traveled. Condition of our roads is quite poor, no question we have the highest number of potholes ever and no doubt will take years to repair them. Hopefully nobody had any wind related issues as of late. How many "bomb cyclones" can we have in one season?

This meeting was our rollout for starting our new tech talk series with this month's topic being aftermarket fuel injection. Dave Svoboda who has it installed on his 65 offered to lead our discussion. To enhance our experience Dave invited a guest speaker Brent who works for the supplier he sourced his Holley Sniper Efi unit from. Using the actual parts and a wiring diagram Brent gave us a 15 minute informal presentation on the ins and outs of installation and the benefits involved. Very informative followed by a Q&A session. Dave also shared his experiences with the group. If you are looking for easier starting and more efficient operation aftermarket fuel injection might be a good match for you. Parts and installation costs will vary depending upon how you choose to set it up. Fuel injection runs at higher fuel pressures than a carb so a completely redesigned fuel system including an electric fuel pump and return line is required. Unit

New owners, pricing and policies especially for room rentals. The short version is that our number of attendees will determine what we get and our per person co-pay. Unlimited as is our normal requires 50 attendees. Allow me to back burner the co-pay discussion and ask for **RSVP's NOW**. If we don't hit 50 unlimited will not be available to us. Set-up catering is basically the same menu just not all you can eat for 20 people and up. Great BBQ

either way..... Back 40 at Tilden will be a go.

On to Xmas, please note we have not booked the facility, so date is TBD based on Back 40 availability. As I mentioned last month it will be \$65 PER PERSON out of pocket prepay after a club contribution of \$15 per person when/if we book the room. Full disclosure, cost BEFORE club contribution is \$79.36 all in. Charges include food \$1170, room rental of \$400, bartender \$250, gratuity \$364, and tax \$197 totaling \$2381 divided by 30.

At last Thursday's meeting a few members confirmed they are ok at \$65 per. So, if you would like to go RSVP to me asap and we will see if we can hit the required attendance target of 30. Marsha and I will join you. So, Xmas at Back 40 is a maybe. The sooner we know the

level of interest the sooner we can move forward and plan accordingly.
